## **2010 COUNTY RESTRICTED CHAMPIONSHIPS**

### **RULES AND CONDITIONS**

- 1 All competitors must be affiliated to Badminton England or to a national association affiliated to the Badminton World Federation. Junior players as defined in the Badminton England rules are exempt from this condition, providing that they attend a school in Oxfordshire.
- 2 Players wishing selection to the County 1st, 2nd and 3rd teams must enter this event.
- 3 Entrants shall be qualified to play for Oxfordshire Badminton Association either by birth or residence.
- 5 The committee reserve the right to refuse entries without assigning a reason, also to alter or modify the programme in any way as they see fit. If it is necessary to restrict entries, this shall be done where possible on merit.
- 5 Entries must reach the tournament secretary by Friday 3rd September 2010. The committee may, at its discretion, accept entries/fees after this date. Refunds will be made at the discretion of the committee.
- 6 For double events an entry form and payment must be received from both members of a pair.
- 7 All events will be a straight knockout with a plate. This should ensure that all entrants get at least two games. Should any entry be too low, a round robin will be played. The singles events will be played on Saturday up to the finals. The finals and all other events will be played on Sunday. Rally point scoring will be used
- 8 Feather shuttlecocks will be used exclusively in the tournament.
- 9 Clothing shall be in accordance with Badminton England Regulations
- 10 All trophies are perpetual and will therefore remain in the possession of the Oxfordshire Badminton Association.
- 11 Competitors must report on arrival and must be prepared to play at the times stated. Any player not ready when called may be scratched.
- 12 Neither the Oxfordshire Badminton Association nor any official thereof, nor the proprietors of the Centre will be responsible for any damage or loss of entrant's property, for any reason whatsoever.
- 13 The referee's decision in all matters shall be final.
